

Access statement


We operate from the “Cobb” which is the historic harbour of Lyme Regis adjacent to the Town

Access to the Lyme RIB Rides (WDDC Managed) pontoon is via a set of gated steps on the south side end of the “Victoria Pier” Lyme Regis harbour, there is a single hand rail on one side but please be aware the steps can get slippery at certain times. The floating pontoon though work very well can be susceptible to movement and some times require a certain amount of balance to negotiate. Being a tidal harbour the pontoon moves up and down with the tide so a certain times there can be a gap, there is a small hand rail which makes stepping between the pontoon and the harbour steps easier. All customers must wait on the Harbour wall until directed down to the boat by our staff.



Entry to the RIB is over the inflatable tube which has an inbuilt rope to help give a firm hold and specially gripped material on the tube to give good grip even when wet. The boat will always be secured tied both fore and aft to the pontoon so there is not a gap between the boat pontoon. Well padded bench seating with up to four people per seat aft and room for up to 3 on the front seat. The seats have a grab rail at the front and at the sides which are part enclosed.



Mobility and a certain degree of physical ability is necessary to embark/disembark the boat. Lyme RIB Rides staff will advise customers using discretion & courtesy if they feel it would not be suitable to travel at sea with us. Please note none of our staff are medical experts and cannot offer guidance on individual cases, our automatic advice would be if you have concerns please do not participate for your own comfort and welfare. Currently we are unable to facilitate wheelchair users. Please see our T&C for more details.
