- **THOSE WHO HAVE CONSUMED ALCOHOL OR TAKEN INTOXICATING DRUGS.**

Life Jackets:

Wearing a life-jacket is mandatory. In the unlikely event that you find yourself in the water, your life-jacket will automatically self-inflate. Should it not do so, there is a manual inflation toggle which you will need to pull to inflate your lifejacket. You'll be instructed as to the location of this toggle during the skipper's safety brief. Please adjust your life-jacket to the correct fit. They are fully adjustable to all persons and require adjustment to a correct and comfortable fit. (Assistance will be given by our staff). Please do not pull the yellow/red toggle in a non-emergency situation. If you pull the toggle and the life jacket is inflated in a none emergency situation you will be required to pay £30 for resetting the life jacket.

Please remain seated whilst underway and hold on firmly:

When the vessel is travelling at speed, do not attempt to twist or look behind you, maintain a firm grip on seats/grab handles at all times and keep your legs flexed, supporting your weight. This will mitigate any impact/shock, and if at any time during the trip, you feel uncomfortable, have any sort of pain, or simply wish to stop, please notify the skipper or crew immediately by raising one hand above your head whilst holding the grab rail with the other.

You may get wet whilst taking part in this activity:

This will vary according to weather conditions and is beyond our control. We, Lyme Rib Rides and its staff, do not accept any responsibility for any property lost or damaged if brought with you. If you do so, it remains entirely at your own risk whilst participating in this activity. If you take a camera, please only use it when the boat is travelling at low speed or stationary.

Photography:

From time to time Lyme Rib Rides or other authorised parties will carry out photography and/or video recording and/or other forms of monitoring on or in the vicinity of the vessels which may feature visitors.
